

COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS PLANNING COUNCIL

MINUTES TUESDAY, JANUARY 12, 2021

The **regular** scheduled meeting of the Community Corrections Planning Council was called to order at 8:30 a.m. this 12th day of January 2021 in the Conference Room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building by Chairman Dave Stockwell. Linda Atkins, Deputy County Clerk/Secretary, called the roll and those present were:

Members Greg Mashburn, Ed Copelin and Woody Glass were absent.

Others present were: Linda Atkins, Carson Howlett, Deborah Cox, Paul Garcia, Greg Stroud, Dawn Thatcher, Assistant District Attorney Madison Clark and Assistant District Attorney Travis White.

Chairman Stockwell asked if the meeting complied with the **Open Meeting Act**. Linda Atkins answered affirmatively.

After the reading of the minutes of the regular meeting of July 14, 2020, and there being no additions or corrections, Darry Stacy moved to approve the minutes. Judge Jeff Virgin seconded the motion.

A. Items of Business:

1. After the review of bills incurred during the months of July through December 2020, Chairman Stockwell moved, seconded by Darry Stacy, to approve the payment of bills.

2. Deborah Cox reported on the current fiscal year budget, expenditures, sentencing, and other program information updates. Ms. Cox asked for a \$5,000.00 increase since they are doing well this year as far as sentencing people into the program. She said that forty-six people were sentenced this year as opposed to last year with the number of thirty-five people and is anticipating asking for another increase in the budget and if that is not available it can come out of the \$60,000 for the Administration Fee Fund and that amount could be supplemented. She said that they are good as far as funding.

4. A supervision overview and absconder status report by Court Related Services and DOC Officer Dawn Thatcher were presented. Dawn Thatcher said that her office has been down with COVID and asked to be kept in everyone's thoughts and prayers.
