MINUTES

TUESDAY, JANUARY 12, 2021

The **regular** scheduled meeting of the Community Corrections Planning Council was called to order at 8:30 a.m. this 12th day of January 2021 in the Conference Room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building by Chairman Dave Stockwell. Linda Atkins, Deputy County Clerk/Secretary, called the roll and those present were:

Chairman Stockwell asked if the meeting complied with the **Open Meeting Act**. Linda Atkins answered affirmatively.

After the reading of the minutes of the regular meeting of **July 14, 2020**, and there being no additions or corrections, Darry Stacy moved to **approve** the minutes.

A. Items of Business:

1. After the **review of bills** incurred during the months of July through December 2020, Chairman Stockwell moved, seconded by Darry Stacy, to **approve the payment of bills**.

2. Deborah Cox reported on the current fiscal year budget, expenditures, sentencing, and other program information updates. Ms. Cox asked for a \$5,000.00 increase since they are doing well this year as far as sentencing people into the program. She said that forty-six people were sentenced this year as opposed to last year with the number of thirty-five people and is anticipating asking for another increase in the budget and if that is not available it can come out of the \$60,000 for the Administration Fee Fund and that amount could be supplemented. She said that they are good as far as funding.






The Re-Appointment of Woody Glass as a Non-Statutory Board Member whose term expired on November 2020 is approved to begin January through November 2021.


