### MINUTES

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 28, 2022

**C. During Commissioner’s discussions about County Business,** Commissioner Haralson thanked the road crews for doing a great job last week in dealing with the icy weather.


Further, Harold Haralson said, “I understand there is a lot of concern about Access Oklahoma’s announcement. As commissioners, we have always worked with citizens to protect property rights and to ensure that everyone in Cleveland County is treated fairly. While we will continue to advocate for fairness and transparency, it’s important to understand that the legislature has given the authority for making decisions about the proposed turnpike to the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority. I will be happy to assist citizens to interface with OTA, but the county commissioners do not have the authority to determine the route or to impede OTA.

A town hall meeting at 7 p.m. on March 3 at CrossPointe Church, 2601 24th Ave SE, Norman, will allow people to discuss issues. I will be there. 
- D. No comments from the Public were made during this meeting.

Motion carried.


