Regardless of that, he thinks that they have come to some kind of agreement. The massage therapist will work two or three days a week and they will set up an on-line schedule. He will get back with the Committee at the next meeting for more updates on the situation.

4. **George Mauldin gave an Employee Health Clinic Update.** He that things are looking better in Oklahoma and mentioned that the Department of Health had a variety of issues in the news media about their contract tracing. He said that a big concern is the situation happening in Brazil. The cases are out of control and are setting new records almost every day. He said that for the State of Oklahoma there may be an end to the pandemic by early summer. He discussed the immunity and occasional outbreaks. He concluded by saying that things are looking good.

Jacob McHughes complimented George for doing an excellent job and said that everyone appreciates him very much.

B. No **new Business** to present at this time.


