MINUTES

THURSDAY, MAY 27, 2021

The special scheduled meeting of the Cleveland County Budget Board was called to order at 10:45 p.m. this 27th day of May 2021, in conference room 200 of the Cleveland County Office Building, 201 South Jones, by Chairman Darry Stacy. Linda Atkins, Deputy County Clerk/Secretary, called roll and those present were:

C. Items of Business:

1. Rod Cleveland moved, seconded by Marilyn Williams, to **approve** the extension of the Board of Equalization Meeting per Title 68, Section 2863, of the Oklahoma Statutes. Douglas Warr, County Assessor, is requesting that the Cleveland County Budget Board extend the Board of Equalization meeting deadline to no later than July 31, 2021, to allow time to process any late protest.

2. Tammy Belinson moved, seconded by Marilyn Williams, to **approve Transfer of Funds**, from the following:

- a. **From** OSU Extension, Travel, 100810-53000, \$4,000.00, **to** OSU Extension, Capital Outlay, 100810-55000, \$4,000.00.

b. From Sheriff, Sheriff GF Travel, 100500-53000, \$6,274.73, to Sheriff, Sheriff GF M&O, 100500-54000, \$6,274.73

The vote was: Darry Stacy, yes; Tammy Belinson, yes; Kent Richie, yes; Rod Cleveland, yes; Billijo Ragland, yes; Marilyn Williams, yes.
Motion carried.

(At this point, Commissioner Harold Haralson entered the meeting.)

D. During Budget Board Members discussions about County Business, Commissioner Cleveland discussed that the latest guidelines from the American Rescue Act is that the \$27.0 million can be deposited in interest bearing accounts.

Further discussion was had concerning Commissioner Cleveland asking the County Clerk to contact the Clerk's Association on its thought about moving to a September 20 or October 1, to match the Budget legislation. It might help with the protest time and in getting all information needed.

Tammy Belinson said that it would make the county to go through the Budget process once.

Rod Cleveland said that it would have to be a change for all counties and become a State Law.

Tammy Belinson said she will send out something to the County Clerk's Association to get feedback. She said that the big bonus would only have to do the budget once.

Darry Stacy recommended talking to the State Auditor's Office first.

Rod Cleveland said that this will be added to the list of bills and will start talking to legislatures.


E. No comments from the Public were made at this time.


